- If the mare returns in heat in an unusual way: research other bacterial diseases on the cervix.
- If the mare is changed from one stallion to another during the course of the breeding season:
 - New CEM test
 - New EVA test
 - These should be taken no sooner than 7 days after the mare was last covered by the original stallion. - Previous results must be submitted.
- If the mare is changed from boarding studs, new tests (all of them) will be required.
- Additional swabs may be required in certain circumstances at the stallion stud manager's discretion.

*HIGH RISK REQUIREMENTS:

Two negatives clitoral swabs (sinus and fossa) AND a cervical swab 7 days apart, taken during oestrus, after the 1st of January. Then follow the "Low Risk" regulations above.
